
By Mr. Murphy of Malden, petition of Robert F. Murphy (approved by the mayor and city council) that the city of Malden be authorized to pension John J. Murphy, a former school janitor in said city. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF JOHN J. MURPHY, A FORMER SCHOOL JANITOR IN THE CITY OF MALDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Malden is hereby au-
2 thorized to pay John J. Murphy, a former school
3 janitor, a pension in the sum of eleven hundred
4 and twenty-five dollars and seventy-five cents per
5 annum, the said sum being equivalent to one half
6 the highest annual salary received by said John J.
7 Murphy. Said payment shall be retroactive to April
8 twenty-third, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, and
9 there shall be deducted from said payments the sums
10 heretofore paid to said John J. Murphy by said city
11 on account of said pension.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
