### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF THE PENSIONS OF CERTAIN RETIRED TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law,
- 2 the pension of every teacher who was retired prior to
- 3 nineteen hundred and forty-six shall be paid in
- 4 monthly installments.
