AN ACT RELATIVE TO REDUCTIONS IN THE TOTAL CREDIT
OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CONTRIBUTORY
RETIREMENT SYSTEMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law,
2 no reduction will be made from the total credit of any
3 city, county or state employee in the contributory
4 retirement system having forty years or more to his
5 or her credit in said system after having reached the
6 age of sixty years.
