## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT TO CREDIT ANY EMPLOYEE OF THE COMMONWEALTH WHO IS INJURED DURING THE COURSE OF HIS EMPLOYMENT WITH CONTINUOUS SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 If an employee of the commonwealth is injured
- 2 during the course of his employment, he shall be
- 3 credited with continuous service for the purpose of
- 4 computing vacation benefits, notwithstanding his
- 5 sick leave and compensatory time have been ex-
- 6 hausted, or if he brings suit for damages caused by
- 7 such injuries.
