By Mr. Vaughan of Belmont, petition of John W. Vaughan relative to the salaries of court officers in attendance upon the Superior Court, the Probate Court and the Land Court in Suffolk County. Public Service.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARIES OF COURT OFFICERS
IN ATTENDANCE UPON THE SUPERIOR COURT, THE
PROBATE COURT AND THE LAND COURT IN SUFFOLK
COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 221 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 73, as amended by section 1 of
3 chapter 427 of the acts of 1946, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following:—

5 *Section 73.* Each officer in attendance upon the
6 superior court in Suffolk county who is appointed
7 under section seventy shall receive from said county
8 in full for all services performed by him such salary
9 as shall be fixed by the justices of said court. Each
10 officer in attendance upon the supreme judicial
11 court in said county shall receive in full for all services
12 performed by him such salary as shall be fixed by the

13 justices of the supreme judicial court, of which salary
14 five hundred and twenty-eight dollars shall be paid
15 by the commonwealth and the remainder by said
16 county. The officer in attendance upon the land court
17 in said county shall receive in full for all services
18 performed by him such salary as shall be fixed by the
19 judges of said court. Each officer in attendance upon
20 the probate court in said county shall receive in full
21 for all services performed by him such salary as shall
22 be fixed by the judges of said court.
