AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ALLOWANCE OF PERIODS OF  
MILITARY OR NAVAL SERVICE AS CREDITABLE SERVICE  
UNDER CERTAIN CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 The second paragraph of section 9 of chapter 708  
2 of the acts of 1941, added by chapter 699 of the acts  
3 of 1945, is hereby amended by adding at the end the  
4 following sentence:— Such member shall be en-  
5 titled to the benefits aforesaid notwithstanding that  
6 his return to employment as a teacher occurred more  
7 than two years after the termination of his military  
8 or naval service.
