AN ACT MAKING VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II ELIGIBLE TO BE APPOINTED TO CERTAIN POSITIONS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE UPON COMPLETING MUNICIPAL AND STATE EDUCATIONAL COURSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 All veterans of World War II who successfully  
2 complete municipal or state educational courses  
3 provided for war veterans shall be qualified for ap-  
4 pointment to any position in the public service for  
5 which educational qualifications are provided by  
6 any law, rule or regulation.
