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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

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### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF CERTAIN GRADE CROSSINGS IN THE CITY OF SALEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The department of public works is hereby author-  
2 ized and directed to cause the elimination of the  
3 Norman street, the Mill street and the North street  
4 grade crossings in the city of Salem by the construc-  
5 tion of state highway viaducts over the right of way  
6 of the Boston and Maine Railroad, starting at or  
7 near Town House square and connecting with Canal  
8 street, in said city; provided, however, that such  
9 construction shall be carried on and completed in such  
10 a way that said railroad can build a new railroad sta-  
11 tion to replace its present station in said Salem, such  
12 new station to be similar to the North Station, so  
13 called, in the city of Boston, with a "Salem Garden",  
14 so called, to be provided for on the second floor of  
15 such new station building.

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
