By Mr. Dean of Oakham, petition of George W. Dean that the Metropolitan District Commission be authorized to enlarge the outdoor swimming pool constructed by said commission in the town of Holden. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROVIDING SUITABLE OUTDOOR PUBLIC BATHING FACILITIES IN THE TOWN OF HOLDEN BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission
2 is hereby authorized and directed to enlarge the out-
3 door swimming pool constructed by said commission
4 in the town of Holden under the provisions of chapter
5 three hundred and forty-six of the acts of nineteen
6 hundred and thirty-four. For said purpose, said
7 commission may expend such sums as may hereafter
8 be appropriated therefor, and the sums so expended
9 shall be added to the annual assessments upon the
10 cities and towns comprising the metropolitan water
11 district, and apportioned and collected as provided
12 by section twenty-six of chapter ninety-two of the
13 General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of providing bathing
2 facilities at Eagle Lake in said town of Holden, in
3 addition to those provided by chapter four hundred
4 and eight of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-
5 six, said commission may expend such sums as may
6 hereafter be appropriated therefor, and one half of
7 the amount so expended shall be assessed upon and
8 paid by said town.
