AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SWIMMING POOL IN ROBINSON STATE PARK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of conservation is hereby au-
2 thorized to construct in Robinson State park a
3 suitable swimming pool, together with a beach and
4 adequate bath houses. For such purposes said de-
5 partment may expend such sums, not exceeding one
6 hundred and fifty thousand dollars, as may here-
7 after be appropriated.
