AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NUMBER OF MEN TO BE KEPT
ON DUTY AT FIRE STATIONS IN CERTAIN CITIES AND
TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 At least two men shall at all times be kept on duty
- 2 in each fire station maintained by every city or town
- 3 having a population of more than twelve thousand.
