By Messrs. Giles of Methuen and Collins of Andover, petition of Frank S. Giles, Jr., and J. Everett Collins that the Department of Public Works be authorized to construct a new highway from the city of Somerville to the New Hampshire state line and a bridge over the Merrimack River in the town of Dracut. AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW HIGHWAY FROM THE CITY OF SOMERVILLE TO THE NEW HAMPSHIRE LINE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The department of public works is
2 hereby authorized and directed to construct a new
3 highway from the city of Somerville to the New
4 Hampshire boundary line, over waste lands in the
5 cities and towns of Medford, Winchester, Woburn,
6 Reading, Wilmington, Billerica, Tewksbury, Lowell
7 and Dracut, and to construct a bridge over the
8 Merrimack river in the town of Dracut, for the pur-
9 poses of said highway.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect only upon
2 provision being made for contributions toward such
3 highway construction project by the federal govern-
4 ment equaling ninety per cent of the total cost of
5 the same.
