By Mr. Hannon of Lee, petition of Edward K. Shuttleworth and others (selectmen of Peru) that the Department of Public Works be authorized to maintain and control Route 143 in the towns of Peru, Worthington, Chesterfield and Williamsburg as a state highway. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING ROUTE 143, AS A STATE HIGHWAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The care, control and maintenance of the public
2 highway known as Route 143, which runs from
3 Hillsdale through Peru, Worthington, Chesterfield
4 and Williamsburg, is hereby transferred to and placed
5 in the department of public works, and said highway
6 shall be a state highway and the care, control and
7 maintenance thereof shall be paid out of the Highway
8 Fund.
