AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT BY CITIES, TOWNS
AND DISTRICTS OF WAGES TO EMPLOYEES BY CHECK OR
DRAFT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The paragraph inserted in section one hundred and
2 forty-eight of chapter one hundred and forty-nine of
3 the General Laws by chapter four hundred and four-
4 teen of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-six is
5 hereby amended by striking out the last sentence
6 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following
7 sentence:— The state treasurer may in his discretion
8 in writing exempt himself, and the commissioner of
9 corporations and taxation may in his discretion in
10 writing exempt a treasurer of a city, town or district,
11 from the provisions of this paragraph.
