AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEBT OF THE RAYNHAM CENTER  
WATER DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Raynham Center water district  
2 in the town of Raynham is hereby authorized to  
3 renew a temporary loan issued December third, nine-  
4 teen hundred and forty-seven, under authority of  
5 section seventeen, chapter forty-four, General Laws,  
6 for a period of not more than one year from December  
7 first, nineteen hundred and forty-eight. Indebtedness  
8 incurred under authority of chapter two hundred and  
9 twenty-two of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-  
10 seven, as amended by chapter one hundred and ninety-  
11 three of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-eight,  
12 shall be payable in not more than thirty years from  
13 December first, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, and  
14 except as authorized by this act shall be subject to the  
15 provisions of said chapter forty-four of the General  
16 Laws pertaining to districts.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
