AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF WEST BROOKFIELD
TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SCHOOL
BUILDINGS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 For the purpose of acquiring land and constructing
2 and originally equipping and furnishing an elementary
3 school building and a high school building, the town
4 of West Brookfield may borrow, from time to time,
5 over a period of five years from the passage of this
6 act, such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding
7 in the aggregate one hundred and twenty-two thou-
8 sand dollars, and may issue bonds or notes therefor
9 which shall bear on their face the words, West Brook-
10 field School Building Loan, Act of 1949. Each
11 authorized issue shall constitute a separate loan and
12 such loans shall be paid in not more than twenty
13 years from their dates. Indebtedness incurred under
14 this act shall be in excess of the statutory limit but

15 shall, except as herein provided, be subject to chapter
16 forty-four of the General Laws, exclusive of the
17 limitation contained in the first paragraph of section
18 seven thereof. The amount borrowed under authority
19 of this act may be used, together with any sums bor-
20 rowed therefor under the provisions of chapter
21 forty-four of the General Laws, toward the con-
22 struction of an elementary school and a district union
23 high school.
