AN ACT FURTHER EXTENDING THE TIME FOR COMPLETING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS AND CONSTRUCTION ON PARK LAND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON KNOWN AS THE CHARLESBANK, TO BE PAID FOR OUT OF THE GEORGE ROBERT WHITE FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The last sentence of section 1 of chapter 585 of
2 the acts of 1941, as most recently amended by chapter
3 302 of the acts of 1945, is hereby further amended
4 by striking out, in line 2, the word "six" and inserting
5 in place thereof the word: — ten, — so as to read as
6 follows: — Said transfer shall also be upon the further
7 express condition that if, within ten years from the
8 date of such transfer, such improvement and con-
9 struction at or on said park land shall not have been
10 completed, then the care, custody and control of said
11 park land shall thereupon revert without further act
12 to said park department.
