AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF VACATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE REGULAR OR PERMANENT POLICE AND FIRE FORCES IN CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 111A, as amended by chap-
3 ter 107 of the acts of 1934, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following:—

5 *Section 111A.* In any city or town which accepts
6 this section, all members of its regular or permanent
7 police or fire force shall be granted a vacation of not
8 less than two weeks during each year of their employ-
9 ment, without loss of pay. Section one hundred and
10 eleven shall not apply to the members of the regular
11 or permanent police or fire force in any such city or
12 town.

Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding to the section 137A, as amended by chapter 107 of the laws of 1904, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1. Section 137A. In any city or town which accepts this section, all members of its college or permanent college or the laws shall be granted a vacation of not less than two weeks during each year of their service.
2. Section 137A. Section 137A shall not apply to the members of the regular college or the laws of any such city or town.
