AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HOLDING OF OTHER OFFICES OR POSITIONS BY MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL IN THE CITY OF EVERETT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 355 of the acts of 1892 is hereby amended
- 2 by striking out section 20 and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following: —
- 4 *Section 20.* No member of the city council shall,
- 5 during the term for which he is elected, hold any other
- 6 office or position created during said term, the salary
- 7 or compensation for which is payable from the city
- 8 treasury, nor shall he act as counsel or attorney before
- 9 the city council or before either branch or any com-
- 10 mittee thereof.
