AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE BOSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Paragraph (c) of section 14 of chapter 521 of the  
2 acts of 1922, as amended by section 1 of chapter 204  
3 of the acts of 1943, is hereby further amended by  
4 striking out, in lines 6 and 7, the words "or a patrol-  
5 man in the police department" and by adding at the  
6 end the following:— ; and provided, further, that if  
7 the employee was a member of the police department,  
8 the amount of such additional pension shall, together  
9 with the annuity and pension, be equal to three  
10 fourths of the highest annual compensation payable  
11 to such employees holding positions in the same grade  
12 and classification occupied by him at the time of his  
13 retirement.
