AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF BAR EXAMINERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 35 of chapter 221 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,
3 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 2, the word
4 "residing" and inserting in place thereof the words: —
5 at least four of whom shall be residents, — so as to
6 read as follows:— *Section 35.* There shall be a
7 board of bar examiners consisting of five persons, at
8 least four of whom shall be residents in different coun-
9 ties, one of whom shall annually be appointed by the
10 justices of the supreme judicial court for a term of
11 five years from October first in the year of his appoint-
12 ment, and who may be removed by them. Such jus-
13 tices may fill vacancies.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
