AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF ESSEX TO SUPPLY WATER TO THE TOWN OF HAMILTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Essex may furnish and
2 sell water to the town of Hamilton which is hereby
3 authorized to purchase water so sold. Water so
4 furnished and sold shall be at a rate or rates to be
5 mutually agreed upon between said towns acting by
6 their respective boards of water commissioners. In
7 case of sale, the town of Essex shall deliver the water
8 at the boundary line between it and the town of
9 Hamilton, or at a point as conveniently near as may
10 be agreed upon, and either town may, at its own
11 expense, make such extension of its water mains and
12 such installation of other facilities and equipment
13 within the limits of the other town as may be necessary
14 for the purposes of this act; provided, that such

15 extension and installation as may be made by either
16 town within the limits of the other shall be subject
17 in all respects to the approval of the other's selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
