By Mr. Parenzo of Westfield, petition of Anthony Parenzo that the new bridge to be constructed over Little River in the city of Westfield be designated as the Veterans Memorial Bridge. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT DESIGNATING THE NEW BRIDGE TO BE CON-
STRUCTED OVER LITTLE RIVER, SO CALLED, IN THE CITY
OF WESTFIELD AS THE VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The new bridge to be constructed over Little
2 river, so called, in the city of Westfield to replace the
3 bridge known as the Main Street bridge shall be
4 known and designated as the Veterans Memorial
5 bridge, and a suitable tablet or marker bearing said
6 designation shall be attached to said new bridge by
7 the department of public works upon its completion.
8 Said department shall also cause a tablet to be attached
9 to said bridge bearing the names of residents of said
10 city, who died while serving in the armed forces of
11 the United States during World War I or World War
12 II, or as a result of such service.
