In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE SHALL PAY TO THE WIDOW OF THE LATE COUNCILLOR MICHAEL A. SULLIVAN BALANCE OF HIS SALARY FOR THE YEAR 1949.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Cambridge shall pay to
2 Mary C. Sullivan, widow of Michael A. Sullivan,
3 member of the city council of the city of Cambridge,
4 who died on January seventh, nineteen hundred and
5 forty-nine, the salary which would have been paid
6 to said Councillor Sullivan had he lived for the balance
7 of the term nineteen hundred and forty-nine.

1 SECTION 2. Said salary shall be paid by the city
2 treasurer to the said Mary C. Sullivan at the same
3 time and in the same amounts as salaries to other
4 members of the city council shall be paid during the
5 said balance of the year nineteen hundred and forty-
6 nine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the sum of \$100,000 be and it is hereby appropriated to the use of the City of Cambridge for the purpose of paying the salary of the Mayor of said city for the year 1912.
