AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF SLIPS FOR THE BERTHING OF BOATS IN HYANNIS HARBOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct slips for the berthing of
3 boats at the bulkhead, so called, in Hyannis harbor
4 in the town of Barnstable. For said purpose, said
5 department may expend, subject to appropriation,
6 the sum of seventy-five hundred dollars; provided,
7 that no part of said amount shall be expended until
8 the town of Barnstable shall have paid into the state
9 treasury the sum of thirty-seven hundred and fifty
10 dollars for said work.
