AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PLYMOUTH TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO PROVIDE FACILITIES FOR HOLDING IN SAID TOWN DURING THE YEAR NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY THE STATE CONVENTION OF THE UNITED SPANISH WAR VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Plymouth may appro-
2 priate a sum, not exceeding twenty-five hundred dol-
3 lars, for the purpose of providing proper facilities for
4 public entertainment at the time of the state conven-
5 tion of the United Spanish War Veterans, to be held
6 in said town during the year nineteen hundred and
7 fifty, and of paying expenses incidental to such enter-
8 tainment. Money so appropriated shall be expended
9 under the direction of the selectmen of said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
