AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION TO MEMBERS OF SCHOOL COMMITTEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 71 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 52, as amended by chapter 90
3 of the acts of 1932, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section: —

5 *Section 52.* A city by ordinance, and a town by
6 vote of the town, may provide for the payment of
7 compensation to the members of its school committee.
8 No member of a school committee in any city shall be
9 eligible to the position of teacher or superintendent
10 of schools therein, and no member of the school com-
11 mittee in any town shall be eligible to the position of
12 teacher or superintendent of public schools therein or
13 in any union school or superintendency union or dis-
14 trict in which his town participates.
