By Mr. Dean of Oakham, petition of M. Lawrence Price and others that the town of Paxton be authorized to pay a sum of money to Augustus Mulanney for services rendered to said town. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF PAXTON TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO AUGUSTUS MULANNEY FOR CERTAIN SERVICES RENDERED TO SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of
2 section ninety-one of chapter thirty-two of the Gen-
3 eral Laws, the town of Paxton may pay to Augustus
4 Mulanney for his services as school janitor in said
5 town the sum of three hundred and sixteen dollars
6 and sixty-eight cents.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
