AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF SHARON TO FURNISH AND SELL WATER TO THE TOWN OF CANTON AND TO PURCHASE WATER FROM THE TOWN OF FOXBOROUGH AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF FOXBOROUGH TO PURCHASE WATER FROM THE TOWN OF SHARON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Sharon may furnish and  
2 sell water to the town of Canton, which is hereby  
3 authorized to purchase water so sold.

1 SECTION 2. The town of Sharon may purchase  
2 water from the town of Foxborough, which is hereby  
3 authorized to furnish and sell water so purchased.

1 SECTION 3. The town of Foxborough may purchase  
2 water from the town of Sharon, which is hereby  
3 authorized to furnish and sell water so purchased.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
