AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS AND FIREMEN IN THE CITY OF FITCHBURG.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city of Fitchburg, in computing the retirement
2 allowances of police officers and firemen retired under
3 sections eighty to eighty-five F, inclusive, of chapter
4 thirty-two of the General Laws, shall credit such
5 police officers or firemen with any service actually
6 rendered in any calendar year as a reserve police
7 officer or reserve or call fireman as a part of his con-
8 tinuous service; provided, that such police officer or
9 fireman was appointed a reserve police officer or
10 reserve or call fireman prior to July first, nineteen
11 hundred and thirty-seven.
