AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF BRIMFIELD TO
PAY AN ANNUITY TO HARRIET LOMBARD, A FORMER
SCHOOL TEACHER IN SAID TOWN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the
2 public good and in consideration of her faithful
3 service for more than thirty-eight years as a
4 school teacher in the town of Brimfield, said town is
5 hereby authorized to pay to Harriet Lombard an
6 annuity of seven hundred and twenty dollars per
7 annum, payable in equal monthly instalments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the selectmen of the town of
3 Brimfield.
