AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE HADLEY WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT TO EXTEND ITS LIMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The inhabitants of the town of Hadley
2 liable to taxation in that town and residing within the
3 territory enclosed by the following boundary lines, to
4 wit:— Beginning at a point on the easterly side of
5 River drive in the town of Hadley, at highway bound
6 number eighteen; thence running southeasterly to a
7 point at the foot of Mount Warner at the division
8 line between land formerly of Charles Hawley on the
9 east and land formerly of George White on the west
10 at the center of an old discontinued road leading to
11 Paul Wright's bridge and to the water supply district
12 as described in chapter two hundred and fifty-six of
13 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and sixteen;
14 thence southerly along the center of said discontinued
15 road, and along the westerly boundary of the water
16 supply district as described in said chapter two hun-

17 dred and fifty-six, six hundred and sixty feet more or
18 less to Mount Warner road; thence crossing the last
19 named road and running southwesterly along the
20 division line between other lands formerly of the afore-
21 said Charles Hawley and George White, and along
22 the water supply district as described in said chapter
23 two hundred and fifty-six to land formerly of the
24 heirs of James Hickey; thence southeasterly along
25 land formerly of the heirs of James Hickey and along
26 the water supply district as described in said chapter
27 two hundred and fifty-six to the center line of Breck-
28 enridge road, sometimes known as Long Hill road;
29 thence southwesterly along the center line of said
30 road and along the water supply district as described
31 in said chapter two hundred and fifty-six, four hun-
32 dred and ninety-five feet more or less to the center
33 line of the intersection of Breckenridge road and
34 Huntington road (called Breckenridge road in said
35 chapter two hundred and fifty-six); thence north-
36 westerly along the center line of said Huntington road
37 and along the water supply district as described in
38 said chapter two hundred and fifty-six to the inter-
39 section of Huntington road and River drive; thence
40 crossing River drive and continuing on the same line
41 and along the water supply district as described in
42 said chapter two hundred and fifty-six to a point in
43 the Connecticut river; thence northerly following the
44 course of the Connecticut river to a point where the
45 first course described extended northwesterly, would
46 meet the said river; thence southeasterly, to highway
47 bound number eighteen and the point of beginning,
48 — shall be added to and made part of the Hadley
49 water supply district. The territory hereby annexed
50 to said district, and the inhabitants residing therein,

51 shall have all the rights, powers and privileges, and
52 be subject to all the liabilities and duties pertaining
53 to said district under the provisions of chapter one
54 hundred and forty-six of the acts of the year nineteen
55 hundred and five.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its ac-
2 ceptance by a majority of the legal voters of the said
3 district, as extended under the provisions of section
4 one hereof, present and voting thereon at a legal
5 meeting called for that purpose within three years
6 after its passage. Said meeting shall be called on
7 petition of ten or more of the legal voters of said dis-
8 trict as hereby enlarged, by warrant from a justice
9 of the peace, directed to one of the petitioners, re-
10 quiring him to give notice of the meeting by posting
11 copies of said warrant in two or more public places in
12 the said enlarged district, seven days at least before
13 the time set for the same, and by publishing such
14 notice thereof as the warrant may require in any
15 newspaper published in the county of Hampshire and
16 circulated in the town of Hadley. The said justice,
17 or a member of the board of water commissioners of
18 said district, shall preside at said meeting until a mod-
19 erator is chosen and sworn; but for the purpose of
20 authorizing the meeting this act shall take effect upon
21 its passage.
