5 in so far as the same may have been invalid by reason  
6 of the fact that, upon the change of her name from  
7 Helene L. Hedman, she failed to re-register under her  
8 new name and pay to the state secretary a fee of one  
9 dollar as required by section thirteen of chapter thirty  
10 of the General Laws, are hereby confirmed and made

 PASSED JANUARY TWENTY-NINE

1. Whereas, That the acts of the Legislature of the State of Massachusetts passed on the ninth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, and which relate to the State of Massachusetts and which are in the words and to the effect following, to-wit:
  2. In order to the end that the same may have been amended by reason of the fact that upon the change of the name from the State of Massachusetts, she shall be known under her new name and give to the said statute a new title;
