

By Mr. Key of Winthrop, petition of Walter Smith and another (selectmen) that provision be made for protection of the shore of the town of Winthrop between Great Head and Bay View Avenue. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE SHORE
OF THE TOWN OF WINTHROP BETWEEN GREAT HEAD
AND BAY VIEW AVENUE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The department of public works is hereby author-
2 ized and directed to erect a seawall on the easterly
3 shore of the town of Winthrop south of Cottage Hill
4 or Great Head, so called, beginning at the end of the
5 existing wall at or near Petrel street and extending in
6 a southerly direction to Bay View avenue. For said
7 purpose said department may expend, subject to ap-
8 propriation, the sum of twelve thousand dollars,
9 together with the sum of twelve thousand dollars to
10 be provided by the town of Winthrop. No work shall
11 be begun until said town has assumed liability in the
12 manner provided by section twenty-nine of chapter
13 ninety-one of the General Laws for all damages that
14 may be incurred thereunder and shall have deposited
15 in the state treasury the sum of twelve thousand
16 dollars for the purpose herein set forth.
