AN ACT DESIGNATING THE OVERPASS ON MEMORIAL DRIVE AT THE TERMINUS OF BOSTON UNIVERSITY BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE AS THE MAJOR JOSEPH PAUL BOUCHER OVERPASS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The overpass on Memorial Drive at
2 the terminus of Boston University bridge in the city
3 of Cambridge shall be known and designated as the
4 Major Joseph Paul Boucher Overpass, and a suitable
5 tablet bearing said designation, and also the names of
6 all persons from ward five in said city who lost their
7 lives while serving in the armed forces of the United
8 States during World War I or World War II, shall be
9 erected and maintained at said overpass by the met-
10 ropolitan district commission.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
