AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PITTSFIELD TO BOR-ROW MONEY FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. For the purpose of acquiring land and
