AN ACT PLACING THE LABOR SERVICE OF THE STATE AIRPORT MANAGEMENT BOARD WITHIN THE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 31 of the General
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by
3 adding at the end the following new paragraph:—

4 The labor service of the state airport management
5 board.

1 SECTION 2. The persons employed on May first,
2 nineteen hundred and forty-nine, in positions in the
3 classified labor service in the service of the state air-
4 port management board may continue to serve in
5 such positions and shall be deemed to be permanently
6 appointed thereto without being required to serve any
7 probationary period.
