By Mr. James A. O'Brien of Fall River (by request), petition of Francis C. Dolan and other members of the House (approved by the mayor and city council) that the city of Fall River be authorized to incur indebtedness for the construction of a trunk sewer. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FALL RIVER TO INCUR INDEBTEDNESS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRUNK SEWER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purposes of constructing a
2 trunk sewer, the city of Fall River may borrow, from
3 time to time, within a period of two years from the
4 passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary,
5 not exceeding, in the aggregate, dollars, and
6 may issue bonds or notes therefor, which shall bear on
7 the face thereof the words, Fall River Trunk Sewer
8 Loan, Act of 1949. Each authorized issue shall con-
9 stitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be payable
10 in not more than thirty years from their dates. In-
11 debtedness incurred under this act shall be in excess
12 of the statutory limit, but shall, except as herein
13 provided, be subject to the provisions of chapter

14 forty-four of the General Laws, including the limita-
15 tion contained in the first paragraph of section seven
16 thereof.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
