RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF BOSTON FORGE COMPANY OF BOSTON.

1 *Resolved*, That, after an appropriation therefor has
2 been made, the department of public works is hereby
3 authorized to pay to Boston Forge Company of the
4 city of Boston a sum not to exceed twenty-seven thou-
5 sand dollars in full compensation for a certain parcel
6 of land owned by said company which was taken by
7 eminent domain by said department in connection with
8 the construction and erection of approaches, structures
9 and alterations necessary for the operation of the Gen-
10 eral Edward Lawrence Logan Airport. No payment
11 shall be made hereunder until there shall have been
12 filed with the comptroller an agreement signed by the
13 president of said company that the amount, if any,
14 paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in con-
15 nection with the passage of this resolve shall not ex-
16 ceed ten per cent of said sum.
