AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE STATUS OF WILLIAM F. RYAN
AS A MEMBER OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY
OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. William F. Ryan, who was provi-
2 sionally employed from November seventeenth,
3 nineteen hundred and forty-three, to January twenty-
4 first, nineteen hundred and forty-eight, as a member
5 of the fire department of the city of Boston, and
6 who was injured in the performance of duty, shall
7 be deemed to be permanently appointed as fireman
8 in said fire department without further examination
9 and without being required to serve any probationary
10 period; provided, that he submits proof, satisfactory
11 to the director of civil service, that such injury does
12 not incapacitate him for the performance of the
13 duties of fireman in said fire department.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon
2 its acceptance by vote of the city council of the
3 city of Boston, subject to the provisions of its charter,
4 but not otherwise.
