AN ACT RELATIVE TO SITTINGS OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF WESTERN NORFOLK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sec-
2 tion one of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the
3 General Laws, as amended by section one of chapter
4 five hundred and ninety of the acts of the current
5 year, sittings of the district court of western Norfolk
6 shall continue to be held in the towns of Franklin and
7 Walpole until the court house accommodations and
8 facilities for said court in the town of Wrentham au-
9 thorized by said chapter five hundred and ninety are
10 available for sittings of said court in said town of
11 Wrentham.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on August
2 twenty-first in the current year.
