AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE DIRECTOR OF REGISTRATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL SERVICE AND REGISTRATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8 of chapter 13 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 601
3 of the acts of 1948, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out, in line 4, the words "thirty-four hun-
5 dred" and inserting in place thereof the words:—
6 four thousand, — so as to read as follows:— *Section*
7 8. The division of registration shall be under the
8 supervision of a director, to be known as the director
9 of registration, at such salary, not exceeding four
10 thousand dollars, as the governor and council may
11 determine. Upon the expiration of the term of office
12 of a director, his successor shall be appointed by the
13 governor, with the advice and consent of the council,
14 for not exceeding five years.

A BILL RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF THE DIRECTOR OF INVESTIGATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL SERVICE AND ADMINISTRATION.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and in the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 12 of the General Laws, as
 2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 601
 3 of the acts of 1905, is hereby further amended by
 4 striking out, in line 4, the words "thirty-four hun-
 5 dred" and inserting in place thereof the words:—
 6 four thousand.—as so to read as follows:—
 7 3. The division of registration shall be under the
 8 supervision of a director, to be chosen as the director
 9 of registration, at such salary, not exceeding four
 10 thousand dollars, as the Governor and Council may
 11 determine. Upon the expiration of the term of office
 12 of a director, his successor shall be appointed by the
 13 Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council,
 14 for not exceeding five years.
