RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS.

1 *Resolved*, That, the Joint Committee on Ways and
2 Means in the course of its investigation and study of
3 any or all matters pertaining to the finances of the
4 commonwealth shall include in said study the subject
5 matter of current house resolve numbered 1498, pro-
6 viding for the reimbursement by the commonwealth
7 to the city of Chelsea for expenses incurred in con-
8 nection with the construction of the new Mystic River
9 bridge.
