### AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC WELFARE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 18 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended by section 23 of chapter 591 of the acts of  
3 1946, is hereby further amended by striking out, in  
4 line 7, the word "eight" and inserting in place thereof  
5 the word: — ten, — so as to read as follows: — *Sec-*  
6 *tion 2.* The department shall be under the super-  
7 vision and control of a commissioner of public welfare,  
8 who shall be its executive and administrative head,  
9 and an advisory board consisting of the commissioner,  
10 ex officio, and six appointive members, of whom two  
11 shall be women. The commission shall receive such  
12 salary, not exceeding ten thousand dollars, as the gov-  
13 ernor and council determine. Upon the expiration of  
14 his term of office, his successor shall be appointed for  
15 five years by the governor, with the advice and con-  
16 sent of the council.

Section 2 of chapter 18 of the General Laws, as amended by section 23 of chapter 261 of the acts of 1940, is hereby further amended by striking out in line 7 the word "and" and inserting in place thereof the word "or" so as to read as follows:—Sec. 2. The President shall be under the supervision and control of a commission of public welfare, who shall be his executive and administrative head, and an advisory board consisting of the commission, ten or twelve, and six appointive members, of whom two shall be women. The commission shall receive such salary, not exceeding ten thousand dollars, as the President may determine. Upon the expiration of his term of office, his successor shall be appointed for five years by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council.
