AN ACT REDUCING THE AGE FOR OLD AGE ASSISTANCE FROM SIXTY-FIVE TO SIXTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section one of chapter one
2 hundred and eighteen A of the General Laws, as
3 amended, is hereby further amended by striking
4 out, in the second and in the twelfth lines, as ap-
5 pearing in section one of chapter four hundred and
6 eighty-nine of the acts of nineteen hundred and
7 forty-three, the word "sixty-five" and inserting
8 in place thereof, in each instance, the word: — sixty.
