In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT INCREASING THE FEE WHICH MAY BE CHARGED
FOR EVENING SCHOOL INSTRUCTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby
3 amended by striking out, in line 8, the words "one
4 dollar" and inserting in place thereof the words:—
5 five dollars, — so as to read as follows:— *Section 20.*
6 The school committee shall, two weeks next before the
7 opening of each term of the evening schools, post in
8 three or more public places in the town notice of the
9 situation of said schools, the date of the beginning of
10 the term, the evenings of the week on which they will
11 be in session, such regulations as to attendance as it
12 deems proper, and the provisions of section ninety-
13 five of chapter one hundred and forty-nine. It may
14 require from each student, not bound by law to attend,
15 an advance payment not exceeding five dollars, which
16 may, at its discretion, be paid into the town treasury
17 to be credited to the school appropriation, or be re-
18 turned wholly or in part at such time and under such
19 conditions as the committee determines.
