To accompany the petition of the Massachusetts Federation of Labor, by Kenneth J. Kelley, secretary-treasurer, for legislation to regulate the rate of contributions payable by employers subject to the employment security law. Labor and Industries.

AN ACT REGULATING THE RATE OF CONTRIBUTIONS PAYABLE BY EMPLOYERS SUBJECT TO THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 14 and inserting in
3 place thereof the following:—

4 *Section 14.* Each employer shall make contributions
5 for the year nineteen hundred and fifty and for each
6 year thereafter at the rate of two and seven tenths
7 per cent of that portion of his payroll as is subject to
8 this chapter. Such portion of such payroll shall in-
9 clude that part of remuneration paid or payable by
10 him to an individual not in excess of three thousand
11 dollars with respect to employment during any cal-
12 endar year.
