AN ACT TO AMEND THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW WITH RESPECT TO THE SERVING OF A WAITING PERIOD AND ELIGIBILITY FOR BENEFITS IN CONNECTION WITH VOLUNTARY QUILTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (e) of section 25 of chapter 151A of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 words "the period of unemployment next ensuing after
4 an individual has left his employment;" and substi-
5 tuting therefor the following: — Any weeks of unem-
6 ployment within a period, not including ten weeks of
7 full or partial unemployment subject to this chapter,
8 next ensuing after an individual has left his employ-
9 ment.
