To accompany the petition of George W. Stanton for legislation to prohibit the use of the same tank for the sale, transportation and delivery of gasoline and fuel oil at retail. Mercantile Affairs.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF THE SAME TANK FOR THE SALE, TRANSPORTATION AND DELIVERY OF GASOLINE AND FUEL OIL AT RETAIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 148 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 710
3 of the acts of 1945, is hereby further amended by
4 adding at the end thereof the following: — No tank
5 which is used for the sale, transportation and delivery
6 of gasoline at retail shall be used for the sale, trans-
7 portation and delivery of fuel oil at retail.
