## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY FROM EXTENDING ITS SERVICES INTO ANY CITY OR TOWN NOT AT PRESENT SERVED BY IT, OR MAKING APPLICATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC UTILITIES FOR ANY EXTENSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections ten A  
2 to ten C, inclusive, of chapter five hundred and forty-  
3 four of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-seven,  
4 the trustees of the metropolitan transit authority shall  
5 not cause plans and specifications to be made for the  
6 extension of its service into any city or town not at  
7 present served by it, nor make any application to the  
8 department of public utilities for approval of any such  
9 extension.
